When Veterans Landscape Company begin developing a 38-acre sub-division, Richard Rybka knew having instant control data would be crucial. "We're not a big outfit and we don't like having to wait on outside surveying services. Having a GPS system seemed like the right way to go because one person could collect data or do stakeout right when we need it," Rybka said.

When Roger Wheeler of Hayes Instrument Company showed them the wireless HiPer Lite RTK GPS system, "I knew it was just what we were looking for," Rybka said. "The other systems we're more expensive and needed a whole other case just for the cables!"
